COOKIE POLICY

By using the website, the user consents to the use of cookie policy accordant with the cookie policy described below. Using the website in on condition that the user consents to the use of cookie policy. However, when the user denies use of cookies, our website will offer limited functions.

§1 What are cookies

- 1. Cookies are small data files, text files, stored on your computer or mobile device hard drive when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by website owners in order to make the website work, or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide reporting information. Cookies allow to recognise user's device and suitably display website properties, providing maximum comfort during usage. Storing cookies enables adequate preparation of the website and its offer in terms of user's preferences server recognises it and memorises for example link clicks, web visits, past actions.
- 2. Cookies contain of website domain name that they originate from, their storage time on the end device and unique number used for browser identification from which the website connection occurs.
- 3. Cookies are used for:
 - Adjustment of website contents to user's preferences and use of website optimisation,
 - Sustaining user's session while logging into webpage which does not require re-logging on each of the website's subpages,
 - Creating animated statistics, that help determine how the user exploits the webpage and therefore improve its structures and contents,
- Delivering website visitors promotional contents adjusted to their interests.
- 4. Cookies are not used for user's identification and his/her identity cannot be determined on their basis.

§2 Types of cookies

- 1. Basic classification of cookies:
- a) Persistent cookies are cookies saved on your computer and that are not deleted automatically when you quit your browser.
- b) Session cookies are temporary cookie files that are automatically deleted when you quit your browser.
- 2. Detailed classification of cookies:
- a) Cookies distinguished by indispensability for the execution of the service (that includes functional cookies that ensure proper functioning of the website, and their installation does not require your permission and essential cookies that automatically placed on your computer when you access a website or take certain actions on a website)
- b) Cookies distinguished by its origin: first-party cookies that are created and stored directly by the website and third-party cookies that are created by domains that are not the website.

c) Cookies distinguished by intended use (files used for configuration, safety and reliability
of the service, authentication, promotion, or adjustment of displayed information based
on user's location).

§3 Personal data

- 1. The use of cookies to adjust website contents to user's preferences does not mean in any way gathering information that would lead to user's identification, however, some information may at times may be of personal data nature and it is data that allows assigning specific behaviours to specific user.
- 2. Personal data gathered by cookies can only by collected in order to carry out certain functions for the user. Such data is encrypted in a way that prevents access to unauthorised persons.

§4 Changing cookies settings and its deletion

- 1. Cookies used by this website are not harmful to either the user or the end device used by the user, so in order for the website to function correctly, it is recommended that the cookie policy is accepted on the browser.
- 2. In many cases, the software used to browse websites allows by default for the information to be stored in form of cookies and on other similar technologies on user's end device. User can at any point change the preference of use of cookies in his software. In order to do that, software setting must be modified. The way of modifying settings differs in terms of used software (website).
- 3. Detailed information on cookie policy on mobile phones or any other mobile device should be located in the device's manual.
